Interested in becoming a Medical Examiner?

Recent legal changes now allow dentists to qualify to serve as medical examiners. The Department of Health and Human Services is actively seeking dentists to serve in this vital role, and they have asked the Board to share the following information with you:



Subject: Seeking Dentists to be Medical Examiners - \$200/exam

Looking for a new challenge in your healthcare career? Opportunity to serve your community? **Consider applying to become a North Carolina Medical Examiner!**

What is a Medical Examiner (ME)? MEs are clinical professionals who receive special training. They are on call in their communities to investigate, produce a report and complete death certificates for sudden, unexpected, violent, and suspicious deaths.

Who is eligible? North Carolina licensed medical physicians, physician assistants, registered nurses, nurse practitioners, dentists, physical therapists, paramedics as well as certified pathology assistants* and medicolegal death investigators** living in or near the vacant counties.

What are the requirements? Ability to serve one or more designated counties, be on-call based on availability, attend a 4-day training course to continue making an impact in our communities across the state.

Current vacancies: We are searching to appoint at least two Medical Examiners in each of the following counties to serve a three-year term:

- Brunswick
- Columbus
- Cumberland
- Durham
- Guilford
- Halifax
