

in North Carolina since 2013 and was subject to the Dental Practice Act and the Board's Rules and Regulations at all times relevant hereto.

3. On her 2018 Dental Board renewal application for licensure in North Carolina, Respondent disclosed that since her last renewal, she was disciplined by the Rhode Island Board of Dentistry on July 11, 2017.

4. The Rhode Island Board of Dentistry found violations where Respondent placed several amalgam restorations for patient VR, some of which did not meet the standard of care. Specific deficiencies included certain Class II amalgam fillings resulting in excessive material which precluded adherence to proper oral hygiene by the patient.

5. Based on this violation, the Rhode Island Board of Dentistry reprimanded Respondent's license on July 11, 2017 and required Respondent to complete a continuing education course that includes restorative care in Class II restorations.

Based upon the foregoing Findings of Fact and with the consent of the parties, the Dental Board hereby enters the following:

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Board has jurisdiction over the person of Respondent and the subject matter of this proceeding.

2. Respondent was properly notified of this matter and has agreed to the entry of this Consent Order.

3. By having disciplinary action taken against her Rhode Island license, Respondent engaged in unprofessional conduct as defined by 21 NCAC 16V .0101(1) and G.S. § 90-41(a)(26).

Based upon the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law and with the consent of the parties hereto, it is ORDERED as follows:

ORDER OF DISCIPLINE

1. Respondent is hereby **REPRIMANDED** for his violation of 21 NCAC 16V .0101(1) and G.S. §90-41(a)(26).
