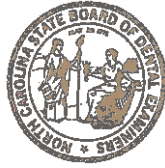

Dear Ms. Parker:

The North Carolina State Board of Dental Examiners has completed its review of your 2017 application for the renewal of your North Carolina dental hygiene license. This information along with the material presented by the Investigative Panel during the June 16, 2017 settlement conference, establishes that on your March 16, 2017 renewal application you failed to disclose charges to the Board. This is the fourth time you have failed to disclose information to the Board. You did not disclose all charges on your original application for licensure in 2006 and when renewing your license in 2008 and 2013, and you were issued Letters of Caution for all three prior nondisclosures. The most recent Letter of Caution issued to you by the Board on May 29, 2013 stated that **any** future violations on your part would result in the case being reopened and disciplinary action taken against your license.

Based on the information available, the Board has concluded that you engaged in conduct involving fraud, deceit or misrepresentation in attempting to renew your dental hygiene license, in violation of G.S. 90-229(a)(1). For this reason, the Board proposes to officially reprimand you. An official reprimand includes placing a copy of this letter in your permanent file, posting a copy of the reprimand on the Board's website for approximately three months and sending a copy to the National Practitioner Data Bank.

If you do not wish to accept this reprimand you have a right to request a formal hearing. This request must be in writing, and must be made within thirty (30) days of the receipt of this letter. Please indicate your acceptance of the reprimand by signing below and returning this letter to the Board office.
