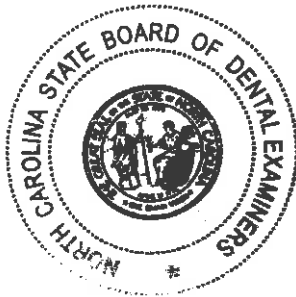
Pursuant to G.S. 150B-3(c), the North Carolina State Board of Dental Examiners (Board) finds that the public health, safety and welfare requires emergency action and hereby summarily suspends License Number 7922 issued to Ila Nicole Bradley, R.D.H. (Respondent), effective upon service of this Order. This action is being taken based on information recently received by the Board that Respondent is at this time unsafe to practice. It is the Board's opinion that Respondent constitutes a threat to the public health, safety, and welfare. Therefore, Respondent shall immediately cease the practice of dental hygiene in North Carolina and surrender her license and current renewal certificate pending further order of the Board.

The Board's summary suspension is not a final agency decision concerning Respondent's license to practice as a dental hygienist in the future. Formal proceedings in this matter will be promptly commenced and determined if Respondent submits a written request for a formal hearing to the Board. Absent such a written request, a formal hearing will be scheduled as soon as practicable. Respondent will be served with a Notice of Hearing containing the allegations to be heard in accordance with G.S.

150B-38(b). The summary suspension shall remain in effect while the investigation is pending and until further order of the Board.


